Thank you for joining us!

Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with our house rules.

- Exercise your dog at the designated area to the right of the Training Center entrance. Please remain outside of the fenced area that is designated for agility. A waste bucket and scoop are provided for your convenience as well as baggies for cleanup. Please keep your dog on leash and under control at all times. Although your dog may be fine, others may not be so willing to get along. Please respect the Hospital area and stay close to the Training Center.
- You are responsible for your dog's elimination within the Training Center as well as outside. We will provide you with paper towels and sanitizer; you are responsible for your own poo bags. Remember to bring them with you whenever you leave your house. This promotes responsible ownership.
- Family members and spectators are welcome but must remain in the seated area during the training session. Only one handler at a time working the dog is allowed.
- Using equipment is not allowed without a trainer's permission. Some of our equipment can be dangerous for some dogs and we want them to have a positive experience to unfamiliar items. This includes children too.
- If your dog is not feeling well **DO NOT BRING THEM TO CLASS**. This is not the time to train them. Please be sure to come without your dog so you know what to work on for that week.
- Bring your dog's favorite soft treats and/or toys to class for rewards. Have the treats cut up in tiny pieces and easily accessible.
- **NEVER HIT or Yell out commands to your dog!** Hitting your dog will only make them afraid of you.
- No smoking is permitted in the building.
- Class fees are non-refundable. It is your responsibility to attend all classes.
- Class cancellations will be notified by phone due to bad weather or emergency situations. That class will be added on to the end of that session.
- Please wear proper foot attire while training your dog to prevent accidents. No flip flops permitted in the center while training.
